This pretty scalloped plate belonged to my paternal grandmother, Jennie Florence Seitz Hendee. I do not know any other history on it.

It has one broken piece, which shows from the back, but is not that noticeable from the front. It measures 8½" in diameter.

I have enjoyed displaying it on the what-not shelf in my antique study, as seen on the next page.

The pottery mark on the back reads, "New Habsburg Austria" and has a dot.



I was not able to find much information online, nor learn the name of the pattern. Items on eBay called similar designs a "pink rose garland." Some such items were hand-painted. One site stated, "The name Habsburg is the name of the US-based New York importer of china from Austria." Dates on the various websites dealing with New Habsburg were around 1900.
